- 1) How have you seen God work in your life this week?

- 3) Read John 21:15-25. What is your initial response to this passage? Does a particular word or phrase stand out to you?
- 4) Jesus had previously talked about love. Look up John 13:34-35 and John 14:15. How do these verses further illuminate our passage today?
- 5) Christian tradition tells us that Peter, like Jesus, was killed through crucifixion. He gave His life obeying Jesus' command. What does this teach us about Christian leadership? Does it help us understand Jesus' command, "Follow me!"?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
