- 5) Jesus calls us to love each other as He has loves us (John 13:34-35). Nothing should separate the love that we have for each other. When have you experienced this kind of love in the church? What does it look like to be united by Christ's love?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
