- 1) How have you seen God work in your life this week?

- 3) Read Luke 24:13-24. Why do you think these disciples are unable to recognize Jesus? Have you ever struggled to recognize Him in your life?
- 4) Read Luke 24:25-35. Broken bread was a symbol of Jesus' broken body (Luke 22:19). Why does this help the disciples recognize Jesus? What does that teach us about who we Jesus calls us to be?
- 5) When has your heart been set on fire by God (verse 32)? Who might God be calling you to share the Good News with?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
