- 1) How have you seen God work in your life this week?

- 3) Read Genesis 14:17-24. Abram has just returned victoriously from a battle in which he rescued his nephew, Lot. Who does Melchizedek credit for that victory? What kinds of victories can you thank God for in your life?
- 4) Melchizedek blesses Abram. How can we practically bless our neighbors this week?
- 5) Abram's responds by giving a tithe: 10% of his belongings. Why do you think Abram does this? What does the practice of tithing remind us of? How does it help us grow in trust and generosity?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
