

## CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) How have you seen God work in your life this week?
- 2) How have you struggled to obey God's Word and live out your faith in Christ this week?
- 3) Read Mark 14:32-42. Jesus asked His friends to keep watch and to pray, but they fell asleep. Do you feel like you've fallen asleep in any areas of your life?
- 4) Jesus cries out to God; He laments the suffering ahead of Him. Is there any grief or pain that you need to lift up to God? Is there any way that you need to cry out?
- 5) Jesus recognizes that "everything is possible" for God, but He prays for God's will to be done. Is there anything you need to entrust to God? Where do you need to pray, "Thy will be done."?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
